**Chris Herren**, a former professional basketball player, has built a community around substance use prevention and recovery. He has shown us that even the best can falter, and even the most desperate can rise. An author, motivational speaker and wellness advocate.

With the unwavering support of his family and friends, Chris has been sober since August 1, 2008, and he now shares his story with the goal of making a positive difference in the lives of others. Chris has spoken to over one million students, athletes and community members, sparking honest discussions on the topics of substance use disorder and wellness. As a person in long term recovery, Chris continues to share his story nationally a renewed focus on prevention education and challenging audiences to rethink how we look at the disease of addiction; changing the focus from the last day to the first.

Signed as an undrafted free agent by the Blues in 1988, Kelly Chase played 12 seasons in the NHL, 7 with the Blues. A bruising defender, he racked up more than 2,000 penalty minutes in his career. Highly active in the St. Louis community, in 1998, he received the King Clancy Memorial Trophy. This award is given for charity work with the Gateway Special Hockey Program, a program started by Chase in the early 1990s to help those with developmental disabilities participate in organized hockey. Chase now serves as a color commentator for Blues radio broadcasts on KMOX. In 2008, he was honored with the Jack Buck award for his enthusiasm and dedication to sports in St. Louis. 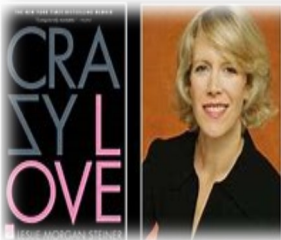
