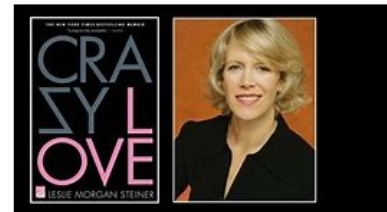

He is not your usual psychiatrist, nor is he your usual educator. He writes and speaks in down-to-earth, jargon-free language and makes learning challenging

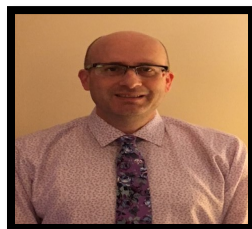

He provided oversight to various programs across the state of Kentucky, including the coordination of Prevention Councils, Mentoring Programs, Faith-Based Initiatives, and Disproportionate Minority Confinement. He has also served as faculty for the NADCP and Drug Court Institute, the National Council for Juvenile and Family Court Judges, the Kentucky School for Alcohol and Drug Studies, National Black Addictions Institute, and the International Treating People of Color Conference.



Scott Breedlove-Mr. Breedlove has 18 years of experience working with clients and serving in various roles including peer, counselor, supervisor, director and trainer.
